Sub: Extension of approval of affiliation to Faculty of Law, ICFAI Foundation of Higher Education, Hyderabad, AP for imparting five year BBA.LLB (H) with an intake of three sections & fresh approval of affiliation to five year BA.LLB (H) with an intake of two sections of 60 students in each sections.

Sir,

The Bar Council of India at its meeting held on **21st February, 2016** considered the inspection report of the Institution. After consideration, Council made the following decision:-

The Council considered the inspection report submitted by the inspection team. After consideration, the Council is of the view that Faculty of Law, ICFAI Foundation for Higher Education, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh be granted extension of approval of affiliation for running five year BBA LL.B (Hons.) course with an intake of existing strength of two sections along with one additional section i.e. total of three sections of 60 students in each section for a period of three years i.e. for the academic years 2016-2017, 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 and also granted fresh approval of affiliation for imparting five year BA LL.B (Hons.) with an intake of two sections of 60 students in each section for a period of two years i.e. for the academic years 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 subject to the following conditions :-

1. Before start new session the Institution shall appoint regular faculty members to teach Non-Law subjects in B.A. LL.B Course and inform to BCI.
2. The Legal aid programmes of the Institution should be strengthened in collaboration with the District Legal services Authority and other competent authorities.
3. College should ensure the payment of salary to teachers as per Rules 22 schedule III, Part IV of BCI Rules.
