
Street Play on Fundamental Duties of Citizens outlined in the Indian Constitution on January 26, 2025



The Legal Aid Society of ICFAI Law School, IFHE, Hyderabad, organized a street play focused on the fundamental duties of citizens as outlined in the Constitution. This event was held in collaboration with Proddatur Gram Panchayat and Zilla Parishad High School, Proddatur Village, Shankarpally Mandal, Rangareddy District, as part of the 76th Republic Day celebrations. The primary aim was to educate the public about the Fundamental Duties enshrined in the Indian Constitution while fostering a sense of national pride and responsibility.

The event began with a street parade featuring active participation from the community. Following the parade, the National Flag was hoisted, and everyone enthusiastically joined in singing the National Anthem. The skit was conducted in the local language to ensure better comprehension among the audience. It aimed to raise awareness among villagers and students about their fundamental duties, underscoring the responsibilities outlined in Article 51A of the Constitution and their role in nation-building. The play addressed issues such as education, environmental pollution, and superstitious beliefs, with the audience actively participating by pledging to uphold these duties. At the end of the street play, every participant read the preamble to promote unity in the society.



The program also included a prize distribution ceremony, during which the honorable guests awarded prizes to students, recognizing their achievements and encouraging excellence.
