DO-RE-MI-AI?

Imagine, you are seated in a concert hall, listening to the orchestra working their magic, performing mellifluous renditions of your favourite musical pieces and once it ends, you realize that the music you just listened to was composed by Al?! I mean, it's not a huge shocker that Al is taking over multiple creative and logical fields such as art,music, writing, math etc,. But does that mean all these talented artists will be out of their jobs? It's debatable.

To give more insight into generative AI for music, I would like to demonstrate Gen AI's capabilities using an example. In February 2019 the Chinese technology company Huawei released a complete recording of the finished version of Franz Schubert's Symphony No. 8. Schubert(1797–1828) had only composed the first two movements of the Unfinished Symphony No. 8 during his lifetime. The finished symphony was performed live at the Cadogan Hall in London, United Kingdom, on February 4, 2019. The final two movements (3rd and 4th movements) were composed by AI present in the Huawei Mate 20 pro phone.

The phone listened to the first two movements of Schubert's 8th Symphony, extracted the key musical features, analysed them and generated a set of melodies suitable for 3rd and 4th movements which were then selected, arranged into an orchestra score by composer Lucas Cantor. Cantor also stated that working with this Al was a rather unique and exciting experience, as he said, "it's like having a collaborator that never gets tired, never runs out of ideas".

I do realise the terms like symphonies and movements might be confusing for the casual listener, so to elaborate, a symphony is a lengthy musical composition for orchestra, usually consisting of multiple large segments, which are called as movements. Symphonies started being composed in Europe in the Classical period(1740-1820) and usually have 3-4 movements, where each movement depicts a theme that could be either consistent throughout the symphony or, like most cases, have drastic changes in the third or fourth movement and then come back to the original theme at the climax which can also completely depend on the composer's style and cannot be generally defined. This is gradually turning into a music history and theory lesson /casually inserts an awkward laugh /. I am going to save the rest of history for another time.

So moving onto the actual debate whether Al can take over music. I think we can gain reasonable evidence for this debate, for both the positive and negative sides, from the reviews given by the audience and experts.

Experts agree that even though the AI was able to detect patterns and replicate Schubert's style(patternised usage of winds and strings etc) it could not maintain the flow of the theme or the emotion of the first two movements. The 8th symphony's first two movements emote through intimate, personal and tragic lyricism whereas the final two movements change the sympony's identity with pretentiously epic and dramatic elements.



The grandiose of the 4th movement doesn't match with the haunting starting point of the movement, to put it in layman's terms, it started off as a tragic haunted movie to an animated Disney muscial. Also, the Al, generated melodies that wouldn't usually be considered as a style that belonged to the classical era but still fit well with the piece.

Finally in Huawei's case one could say that, the Al received both applause by audience and casual listeners but also some criticism by the experts as it couldn't add character to the piece. But some people differed by saying that the objective of Musical Generative AI is not fit in with the old or the existing but add to what already exists, so I would agree with both the classical expert standpoint and the contemporary standpoint. The success of Huawei's AI is completely subjective with respect to different perspectives.

To conclude, Musical Gen Al has a lot of potential, it can be considered as a jukebox brimming with out-of-the-box ideas and melodies and it is upto the creator of music to leverage the capabilities of Al to make amazing music. It most probably would not replace creative jobs but it would rather provide itslef a reliable collaborator that is never tired and can brainstorm with you all the time and it also expected to become an integral part of the process of making music in the future.

Instead of striving for an unattainable ideal, it encourages us to appreciate the inherent beauty of things as they are with all their irregularities and uniqueness. Whether in the well-thumbed pages of a novel or the scribbled benches of the FST, imperfection is to be celebrated as evidence of a life well-lived and a story to be told.

Secondly, Wabi Sabi acknowledges the beauty of impermanence and the inevitability of change over time. Just as semesters come and go, and assignments keep getting graded, everything in life is subject to the passage of time. Rather than mourning the lost time, Wabi Sabi invites us to find solace in the present and nuzzle the sweet memories of the past.

IN THE NAME OF TRANSGENDER SELF IDENTIFICATION:

Is it legal for anyone to refer to someone who seems to be a man dressed like a woman as a "woman"?

Is it acceptable for a transgender person who committed heinous crimes to transition while incarcerated?

The concept of gender self-identification:

Self-identification is when a person does not have to undergo any medical testing in order to identify as the gender of their choice; they only need to reveal their desire. The main reasons that are in favor of not questioning someone's identity are the expenses, time commitment,

dehumanization and discrimination that trans people face every day.

This article delves into the idea of gender self-identification which goes beyond respecting an individual's freedom by invading someone's personal space and using this as an alibi for the crime they committed by claiming to be a transgender person without any medical proof and causing disrespect to the whole transgender community.

Transgender self-identification: The making of a predator Dressing like a woman is never really an excuse for a man to take benefit of others; it does not relieve him of blame for the crime he might have committed. Self-identity can lead predators to commit crimes such as rape and sexual assault, which, in my personal belief, are some of the most heinous crimes. In fact, it provides justification for someone to try and use their gender identity as a reasonable possibility in an attempt to have some charges dropped. I believe it is concerning for both men and women to be able to change their gender on official documents without providing any medical proof of their transition, as it gives predators access to the predators to men and women's spaces like prisons and public restrooms, which is threatening to both genders. These predators, who are transferred from their existing prisons to what they perceive as current prisons, represent a risk to other inmates.

I personally believe that one should not be allowed to change their gender before 18 as they're not mature enough to take such big decisions. Even if one wants to change their gender after the age of 18, he /she must undergo medical procedures and must be recognised by the government to protect the rights of transgender people and also to respect them and their choice. I think that this is the most sensible and efficient way to deal with things.






