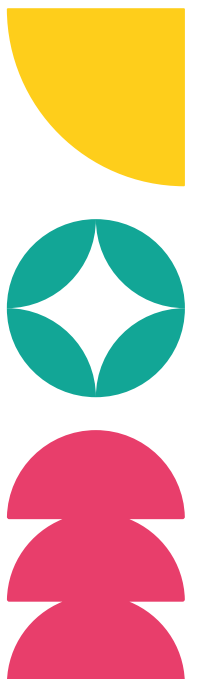

# UBA Village Outreach Activity Report on

31<sup>st</sup> January 2026



As part of our Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) activities, our team conducted village outreach programs at ZPHS Government School, Tangtoor village and ZPHS Government School, Poodhatur village with the objective of creating awareness and providing guidance to school students.



During the visit to ZPHS Government School, Tangtoor, an awareness and guidance session was organized for the students. The session focused on important safety rules that students should follow both at school and at home. In addition, students were guided about future academic options after completing Class 10, where various streams such as MPC and other available pathways were explained. Basic career guidance was also provided to help students understand different opportunities and make informed decisions regarding their academic and professional future.
