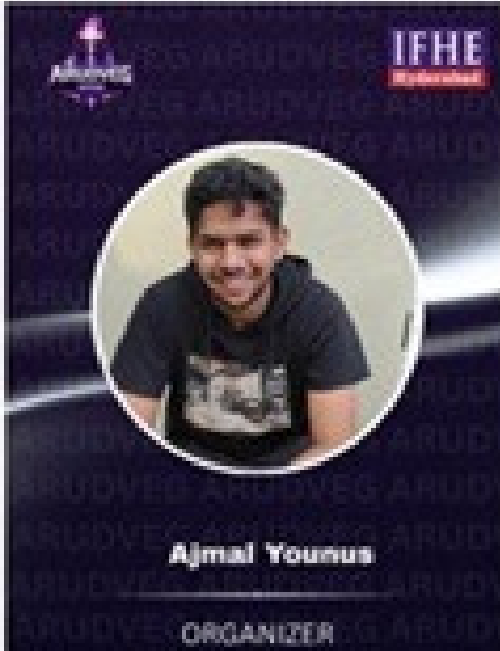
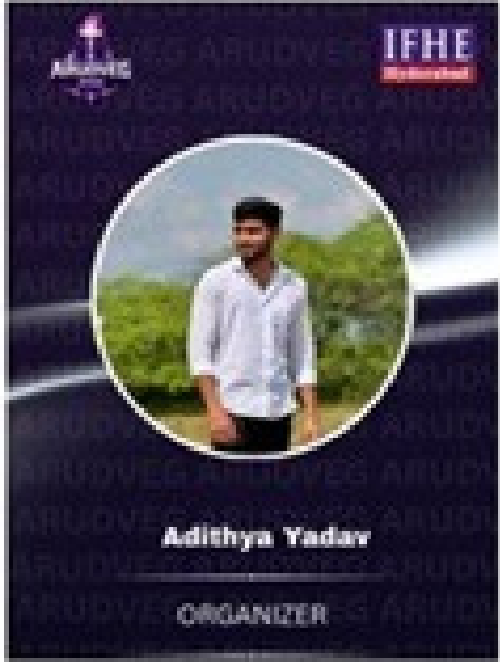
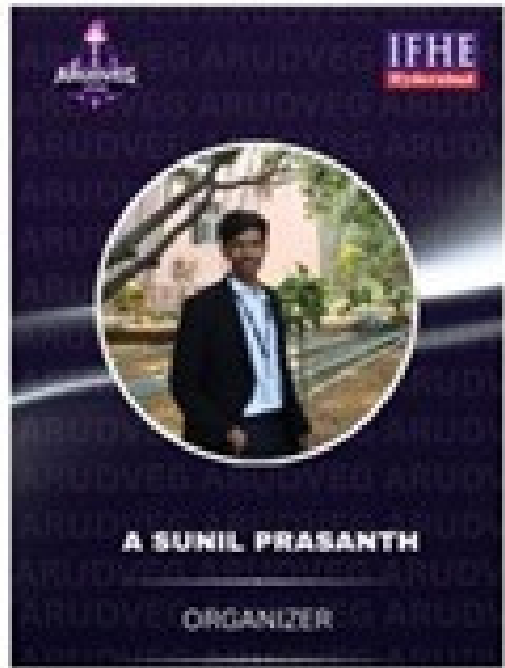
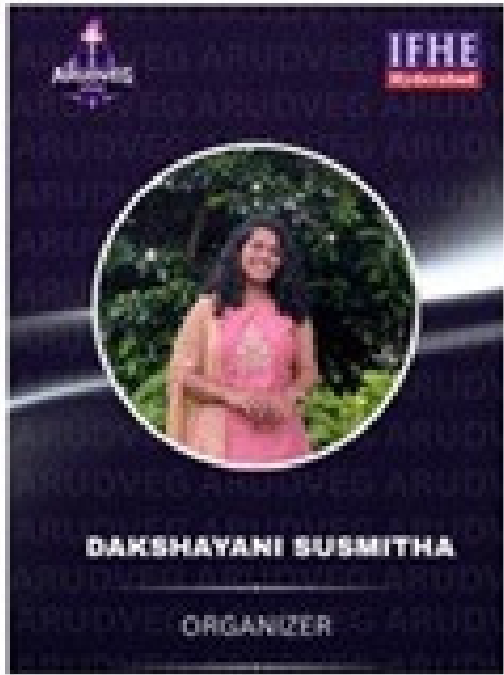
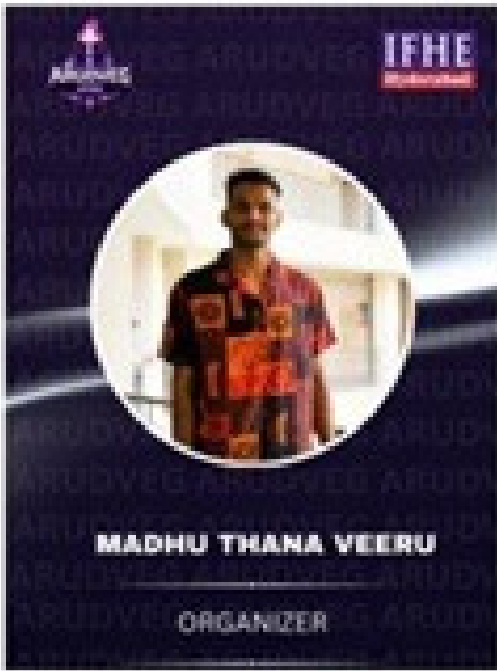
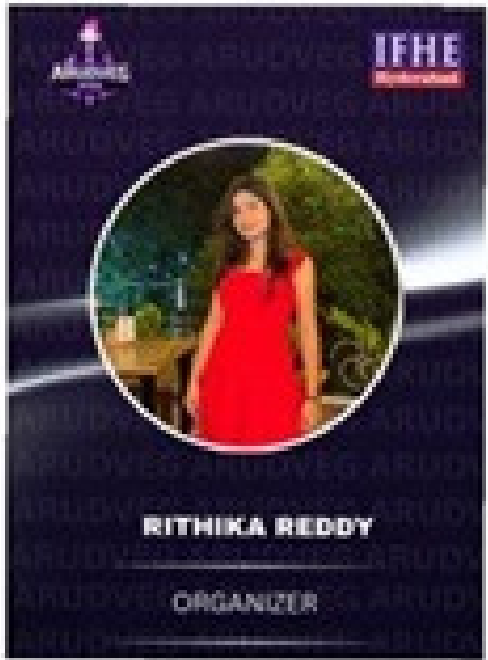
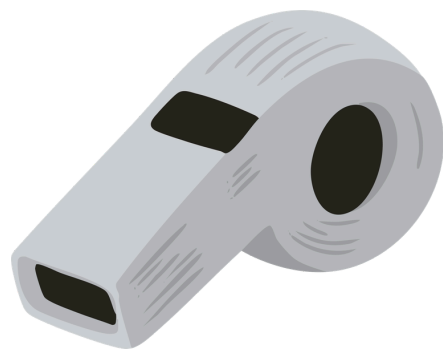
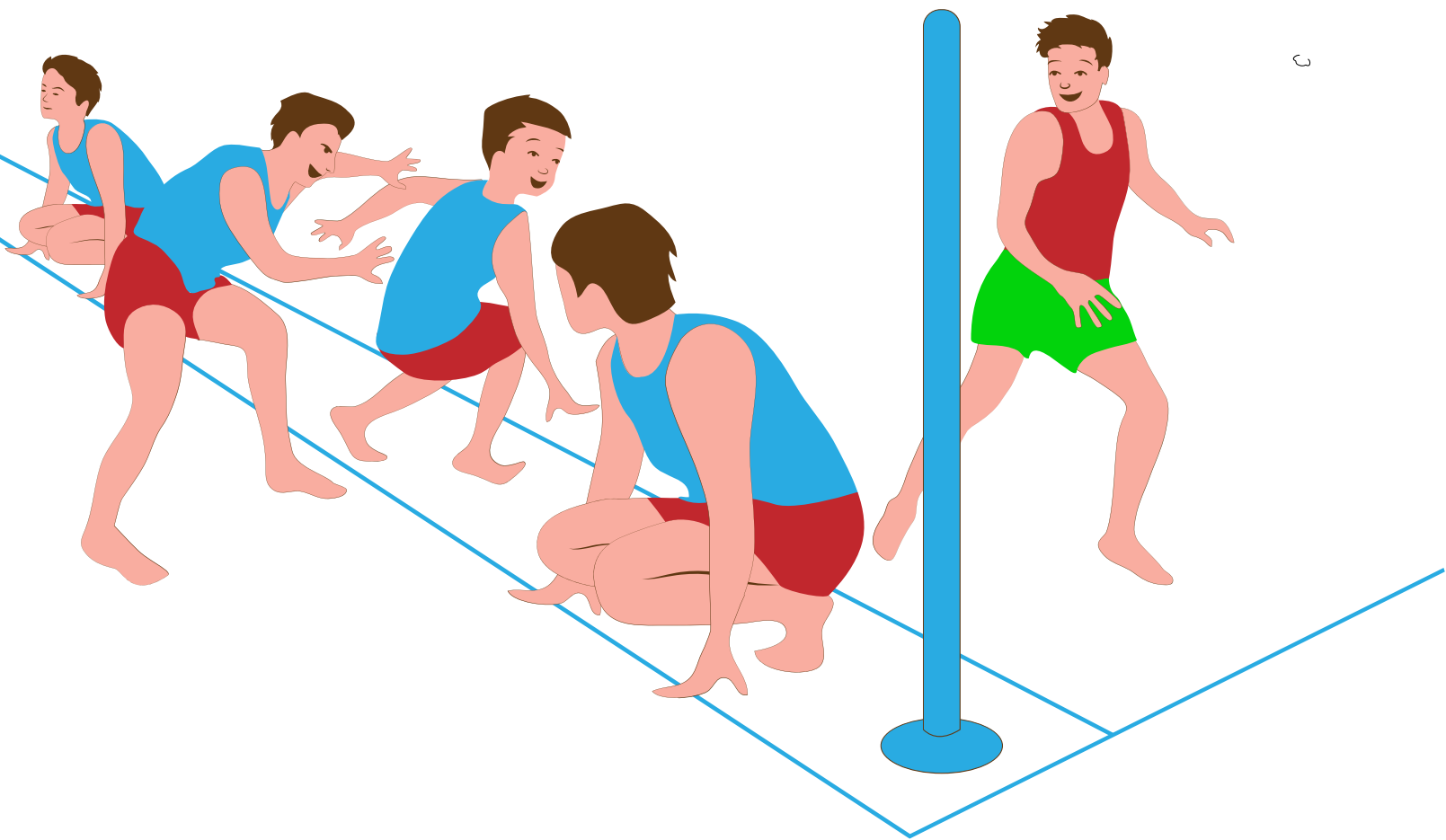
Faculty Mentors
