- **Event Brief**
 - From November 5th to 7th, 2024, the ICFAI School of Architecture organized an intensive three-day Bamboo Furniture and Artefacts Workshop at the IFHE Hyderabad campus, emphasizing sustainable design practices and hands-on learning for students.
 - The workshop was conducted by *Bamboo Made*, a design firm known for its expertise in bamboo-based products, led by architects Ar. Karthik B and Ar. Dolly Chandrawanshi, who brought their extensive knowledge of bamboo as an eco-friendly material. The team also included skilled artisans Anjalamma and

Krishnaaiah, along with seasoned carpenter Narender, who helped students delve into the unique properties and possibilities of bamboo, a material gaining attention for its versatility and sustainability.

- The workshop aimed to provide students with practical, hands-on experience, enhancing their understanding of bamboo as a renewable resource.
- Over three days, participants learned about various aspects of bamboo, from its structural properties and joinery techniques to surface finishes and applications in modern furniture and decorative artefacts.
- Each session involved demonstrations by the experts, followed by guided, hands-on crafting sessions where students could put theory into practice. Students experimented with designing and constructing small furniture pieces and artefacts, integrating aesthetic and functional considerations into their creations.
- The culmination of this workshop was an exhibition held on November 13th and 14th, 2024, at the FST Block, 2nd Portico Lobby of the IFHE Hyderabad campus, where students proudly displayed the products they had created.
- The exhibition was inaugurated by Madam Ms. N. Shobarani, Chairperson of ICFAI Society, accompanied by Vice-Chancellor Dr. L.S. Ganesh, IFHE Hyderabad and Dr. S. Vijayalakshmi, Registrar, IFHE Hyderabad who toured the exhibits and engaged with students, gaining insight into their experiences and creative processes.
- The exhibits showcased bamboo-based creations, from innovative seating and tables to decorative items that reflected the students' newfound skills and artistic flair.
- Faculty members and students from various schools within IFHE Hyderabad visited the exhibition, offering words of appreciation for the students' work. The event allowed attendees to observe the potential of bamboo as a sustainable design material, capable of being adapted for modern needs while preserving traditional craftsmanship.

- Overall, the workshop and subsequent exhibition reinforced ICFAI School of Architecture's commitment to integrating sustainable practices within architectural education. It provided students with an enriching experience that went beyond conventional classroom learning, immersing them in the values of eco-friendly design, innovation, and practical craftsmanship. By bridging traditional techniques with contemporary design concepts, the event also highlighted bamboo's potential as a sustainable material that aligns with modern environmental goals, fostering awareness of ecological responsibility in the next generation of architects.
